

The Burrow lands

The Burrow lands (Figure 1) is the local name used in Kilmore Quay to mean the portion of the sand dunes at Ballyteige Burrow extending north-westwards from the village of Kilmore Quay for 2km approximately to the fence line at Furlongs Road. The property is owned by members of the local community and is held in trust for them by the Directors of the Kilmore Quay Community Development Association CLG. The Burrow lands incorporate the popular looped Kilmore Quay Walking Trail.
